CHWs also communicate with healthcare providers on behalf of patients and the community. CHWs duties and responsibilities include:

- Conducting outreach activities
- Providing health education
- Facilitating referrals and linkage to healthcare providers
- Advocating for the needs and rights of their clients
- Collecting and reporting data on health for grant purpose
